



Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program (ZEVIP)

What is ZEVIP?

The [Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program \(ZEVIP\)](#) is a federal initiative by Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) aimed at increasing the availability of charging and refueling infrastructure for zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) across Canada. The program supports the deployment of ZEV infrastructure in public places, on-street locations, workplaces, multi-unit residential buildings, and commercial and public fleets.

Key Features

- **Funding Support:** Covers up to 50% of total project costs, with a maximum contribution of \$5 million per project.
- **Eligible Projects:** Projects that involve the installation of electric vehicle (EV) chargers, hydrogen refueling stations, and other ZEV infrastructure.
- **Application Deadlines:** Applications are due by **September 19, 2024 (23:59 Eastern Daylight Time)**.

2. **Prepare Your Application:** Gather necessary documentation, including project plans, budget estimates, and environmental assessments.
