

# Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program (ZEVIP)

## What is **ZEVIP**?

The Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program (ZEVIP) is a federal initiative by Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) aimed at increasing the availability of charging and refueling infrastructure for zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) across Canada. The program supports the deployment of ZEV infrastructure in public places, on-street locations, workplaces, multi-unit residential buildings, and commercial and public fleets.

#### **Key Features**

- **Funding Support**: Covers up to 50% of total project costs, with a maximum contribution of \$5 million per project.
- **Eligible Projects**: Projects that involve the installation of electric vehicle (EV) chargers, hydrogen refueling stations, and other ZEV infrastructure.
- Application Deadlines: Applications are due by September 19, 2024 (23:59 Eastern Daylight Time).

- 1. **Review Eligibility Criteria**: Ensure your organization and the proposed project meets ZEVIP requirements.
- 2. **Prepare Your Application**: Gather necessary documentation, including project plans, budget estimates, and environmental assessments.
- 3. **Submit Your Proposal**: Follow the instructions on the <u>ZEVIP website</u> to complete and submit your application.
