Resources and Services Available Through this Agreement	This agreement provides access to comprehensive electricity consulting services designed to help public sector organizations better understand, manage, and optimize their electricity costs and consumption. The agreement provides services including the following. Base Consulting Services: • Analysis and commentary on electricity market conditions, regulations and policies affecting electricity costs, including historical and forward market conditions, HOEP, Global Adjustment, demand, weather and other cost drivers. • Advice related to the management of electricity costs and risks, including unit price projections, cost uncertainty, cost-management strategies and Pass-Through Hourly Electricity Price (PTHEP) analysis. • Assistance with the preparation of annual electricity budgets, cost projections and reports to facilitate cost-effective electricity management, including commodity and non-commodity forecasts and account-level Global Adjustment analysis. • Monthly market and commodity-cost reporting, quarterly information webcasts, and ad hoc/customized reporting on material electricity market, policy and regulatory changes. • PTHEP support, including identifying eligible retailers, assessing potential savings, reviewing historical consumption and demand, and coordinating account additions or removals where recommended.

	Optional Consulting Services: • Advice related to electricity acquisition, including supply and procurement strategies, commodity acquisition planning, procurement documentation, vendor analysis and selection, and support in finalizing transactions with successful electricity vendors. • Electricity account and bill verification, including independent review of commodity, supply, transmission, delivery and other charges; consumption and peak-demand validation; Global Adjustment classification review; and support resolving billing discrepancies or disputes. • Support for energy conservation and demand management plans, including annual energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions reporting, five-year conservation and demand management plans, data validation, facility metrics, weather normalization and regulatory submissions. • Electricity contract volume monitoring and optimization, including monitoring contracted volumes against actual consumption, updating load profiles, optimizing contract volumes and supporting consumption forecasts and utility/contract administration. • Energy management software and related services to obtain, track and manage utility consumption data across Customer facilities, incorporate facility metrics, provide reporting and make data available in raw and/or weather-normalized formats. • Electricity regulatory monitoring and support, including monitoring and reporting on regulatory developments, assessment of regulatory changes, support with OEB matters and other electricity-related regulatory interventions.
